All registered voters residing within the South Lynchies Fire District are eligible to participate in this election. Any persons that will be at least 18 years old on or before November 4, 2014 that are not registered to vote in Florence County, must register to vote by October 4, 2014.

Eligible citizens may offer as a candidate for these offices by filing the required forms at the South Lynchies Fire Department, 345 South Ron McNair Boulevard, Lake City, S.C. 29560 phone 843-374-8690. There is no filing fee. The filing period will be open at 12 noon August 1, 2014 and will remain open during regular business hours until 12 noon on August 15, 2014.

This is a non-partisan election, and no party affiliation will be placed on the ballot.

The polls shall open at 7:00 a.m. on Election Day and close at 7:00 p.m.

At 9:00 a.m. on Election Day, the poll managers will begin processing absentee ballot return envelopes. This process will be held at the Florence County Elections Central Office, 219 Third Loop Road, Florence, S.C. Election Night vote counts will be conducted at the same location.

The Florence County Voters Registration and Election Commission will hold a hearing to determine the validity of provisional ballots in this election On Friday November 7, 2014, at 10:00a.m. This process will be held at the Florence County Elections Central Office, 219 Third Loop Road, Florence, S.C.
